WHERE IS THE EVENT TAKING PLACE?

The Triathlon is now taking place in the swimming pool of [Polehampton Junior School, Loddon Hall Road, Twyford, RG10 9JA](#) and the cycle and run are on King George V Playing Field adjacent.

CAN PARENTS HELP....?

We ask that parents DO NOT ENTER either transition points at all during the event morning. If you wish to marshal in the event, we would love to hear from you.

WILL I RECEIVE ANYTHING BEFORE THE DAY?

No, **all participants are required to register and collect the following on race day:**

- Race numbers
 - one large one to be worn on the front of your body when cycling and running – this has to be put on after the swim with safety pins or alternatively a [race-belt](#) can be worn.
 - one to be placed on the front of your bike with cable ties (provided)
 - one to be stuck to the front of your helmet

Bikes are to be placed into transition AFTER registration at which point they will be checked for basic road worthiness. Your race number **MUST** be attached to the front of your bike and also to the front of your cycle helmet before entering transition.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING/WEAR?

- Goggles
- Swim hat
- Swimsuit/shorts or a [tri-suit](#) (see note below about discount available)
- Towel
- Talcum powder to put in trainers to reduce risk of blisters when putting wet feet into trainers.
- **A correctly fitting cycle helmet must be worn by ALL children taking part**
- T-shirt and shorts to put over swim-suit/shorts if not wearing a tri-suit
- Bike in roadworthy condition **SUITABLE FOR CYCLING ON GRASS**
- Trainers suitable for cycling and running ideally with elastic laces as easier to get on after the swim. Elastic laces available to purchase for £2 on the day.

Please bring only the essential items into transition and leave the rest with your spectators.

ARE THERE ANY SPECIFIC RULES I NEED TO ABIDE BY?

Yes:

- All competitors **MUST** wear a fastened helmet when in contact with their bike.
- **No earphones/mobile phones or MP3 players are to be used AT ALL during the event.**
- **Only marshals in high-viz vests are to assist competitors during the event.**

WHAT HAPPENS IF GET A MECHANICAL ISSUE ON THE BIKE?

Speak to the nearest marshal who will assist you.

WILL THERE BE FIRST AID AVAILABLE?

Yes, supplied by [Beyond First Aid](#). They will be stationed at the swimming pool and the Transition area.

WILL THERE BE A PHOTOGRAPHER AT THE EVENT?

Yes, and photos will be free to download after the event.

ARE THERE TOILETS/CHANGING FACILITIES ONSITE?

Yes, in the Youth Centre.

HOW WILL I GET MY RESULTS?
